5. START / FINISH

The event shall \underline{start} at 10am and \underline{finish} no later than 5:00 pm.

6. ENTRIES

Entries will be open at 9:00am and close at 9:45am on Sunday 15^{th} January 2012

Entry fee: Single: \$25 Family: \$35 for family of two (2) then \$5 for each additional family member, Junior Come and Try \$10 entry fee.

Entry forms must be completed in full and forwarded to the Secretary with the required fee. Cheques and Money Orders should be made payable to **MG Car Club of Tasmania Inc.**

Entries are not contractual until the cheque is received.

The event will be limited to **60** entries accepted in order of receipt.

Documents must be checked prior to competition, including a CAMS Competition Licence, CAMS-Affiliated Membership Card and, if issued, CAMS Vehicle Logbook.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason therefore in accordance with the Provisions of NCR 83.

7. PARENTAL CONSENT

The signed consent of the parent/guardian of any competitor under 18 years of age must appear on the Entry Form.

8. PERSONS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Current Financial members of CAMS affiliated car clubs.

9. LICENCES

The event will be available to CAMS Level 2NS (Non Speed) Licence Holders or higher.

10. SCRUTINY

All vehicles must be scrutineered prior to competing in the event.

Scrutiny at the event from 9.00 am

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

CAMS manual non-production cars such as Specials or similar must be fitted with an approved seat belt and roll bar. Tyre restriction will be no rally, mud snow and winter treads or similar tread pattern.

11. DRIVERS BRIEFING

9.45am at the venue. Attendance by Competitors is Compulsory. If required further briefings will be held during the event.

12. INSURANCE

- 13.1) Public risk insurance has been effected by the Promoters / Organisers.

13. <u>TIMING</u>

Timing will be by **Electronic Timing Devices** to 0.01 second.

14. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

15. ABANDONMENT

The organisers reserve the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the event in accordance with the provisions of NCR 59.

16. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

Other Prohibited Substances

The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.

17. CLASSES (Motorkhana)

AF/AR: 2WD up to and including 2150mm

BF/BR: 2WD 2151mm – 2390mm CF/CR: 2WD 2391mm –2574mm DF/DR: 2WD over 2575mm

 $\underline{\textbf{E}}$: Four Wheel Drive irrespective of wheelbase

<u>F</u>: FWD Specials <u>G</u>: Rear WD Specials

The maximum number of drivers per car is **four** (4), (unlimited to immediate family at the same address) No driver may compete in more than 1 vehicle. A competitor may compete in a "borrowed" vehicle if initial vehicle becomes mechanical unsafe and is granted permission from the Clerk of Course. Class E – must compete in all 4WD and to compete at the completion of tests by the other competitors, only on dirt/grass surface. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

18. TESTS

Test will be selected from the CAMS Motorkhana Test Booklet and or Supplemental tests.

Start and Finish procedures for each test shall be in accordance with the National Motorkhana Code.

Tests will be advised to Competitors at time of Entry/Registration.

Each driver shall make a minimum of **one** and a maximum of **two** runs per test.

19. AWARDS & RESULTS

Points will be awarded towards MG Car Club Tasmania Championship based on results of this event.

Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, inclusive of penalties. Penalties shall be in accordance with the National Motorkhana Code.

20. SAFETY / DRIVERS

All vehicles scrutineered shall comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the CAMS Manual.

Apparel must comply with Schedule D of the CAMS Manual.

Adequate footwear shall be worn while competing. Bare feet, thongs or sandals are not permitted.

Drivers of Motorkhana Specials must wear helmets complying with AS 1698 and carries markings to that effect; or one which is other specially approved by CAMS, also appropriately marked to that effect.

Drivers of vehicles to which no windscreen is fitted shall wear adequate eye protection while competing.
